### **Baby Safe Haven Law**

On May 2, 2006, Gov. Douglas signed the Baby Safe Haven Bill into Law, making it legal for parents to give up their babies—anononymously--at designated Safe Havens throughout the State. Under this law, any person can bring a baby, up to 30 days old, to a Safe Haven in Vermont. This includes any police or fire station, health care facility, place of worship, adoption agency licensed in Vermont, or a place a 911 emergency responder agrees to meet a person to receive a baby. To be covered by law, the person must hand the baby to a volunteer or employee of a Safe Haven. For more information see [www.babysafehaven.vermont.gov](http://www.babysafehaven.vermont.gov).
