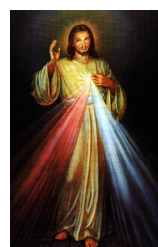

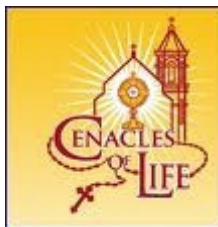
**BISHOP'S FUND**
