The **Plenary Indulgence** is granted to all the faithful who are truly repentant who, in church or in chapel, devoutly attend the divine Sacrifice of Mass and offer prayers to Jesus Christ the Eternal High Priest, for the priests of the Church, and any other good work which they have done on that day, so that he may sanctify them and form them in accordance with His Heart, as long as they have made expiation for their sins through sacramental confession and prayed in accordance with the Supreme Pontiff's intentions: on the days in which the Year for Priests begins and ends, on the day of the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the pious passing of St. John Mary Vianney, on the first Thursday of the month, or on any other day established by the local Ordinaries for the benefit of the faithful.
